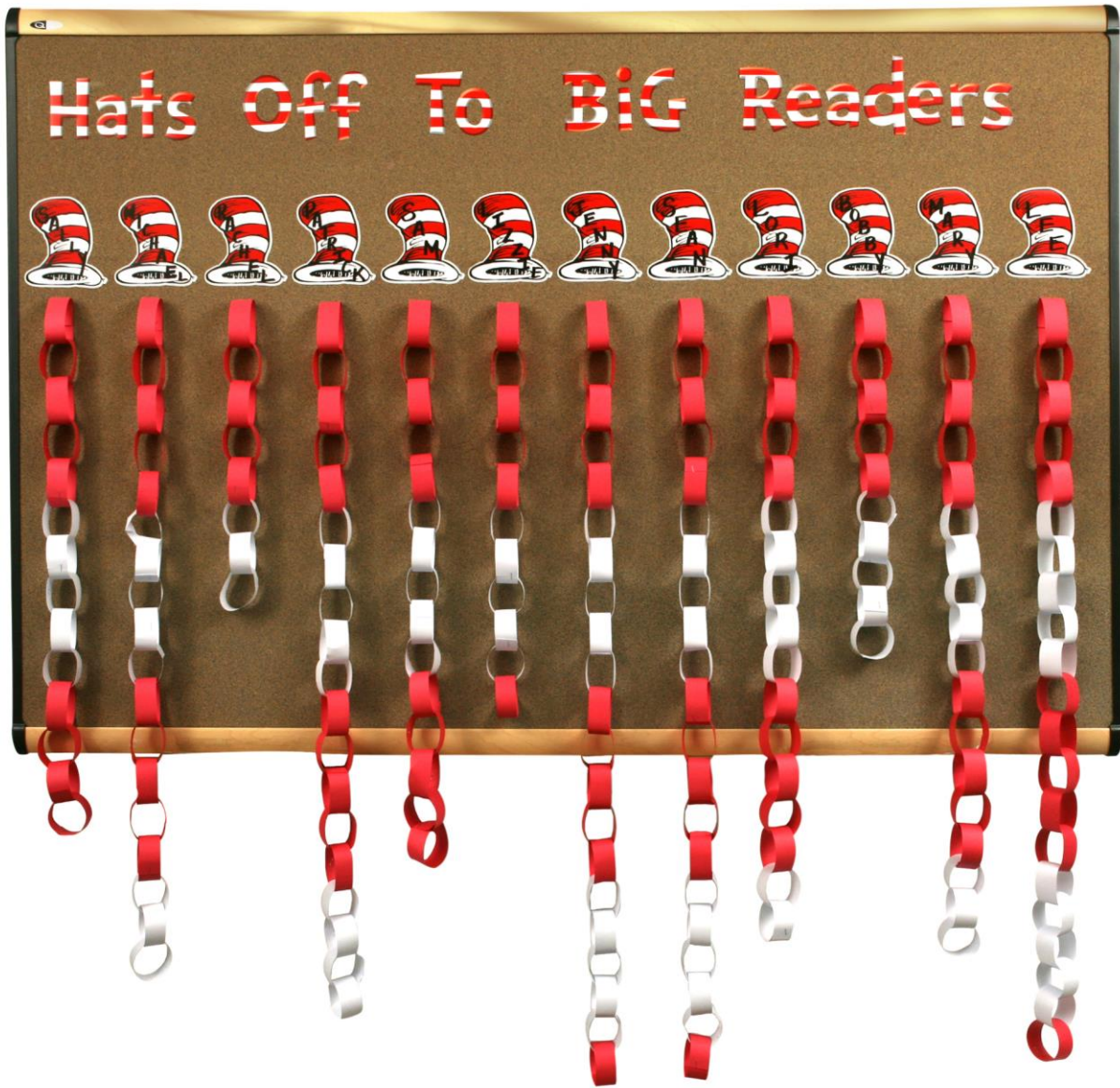


Dr. Seuss™ Reading Bulletin Board Project

Supplies Needed:

1. Red Construction Paper
2. White Paper (similar to printer paper)
3. Stapler
4. Black Marker
5. Dr. Seuss™ Stripe Punch Out Deco Letters (Eureka item #487215)
6. Dr. Seuss™ The Cat's Hat Paper Cut-Outs (Eureka item #841300)

Instructions:

This project allows teachers or parents to track the number of books that children read by creating a "Cat's Hat" out of paper rings that will hang from the bulletin board. 1 book equals 1 paper ring. This is a great way to celebrate during Dr. Seuss' birthday and Read Across America

Step 1: Cut red and white paper into 1.25" strips

Step 2: Write students names on Dr. Seuss™ The Cat's Hat Paper Cut-Outs

Step 3: Hang all Dr. Seuss™ The Cat's Hat Paper Cut-Outs on Bulletin Board

Step 4: As children read books, add on rings under each child's name

Step 5: Use Dr. Seuss™ Stripe Punch Out Deco Letters to create a header or saying for the bulletin board
