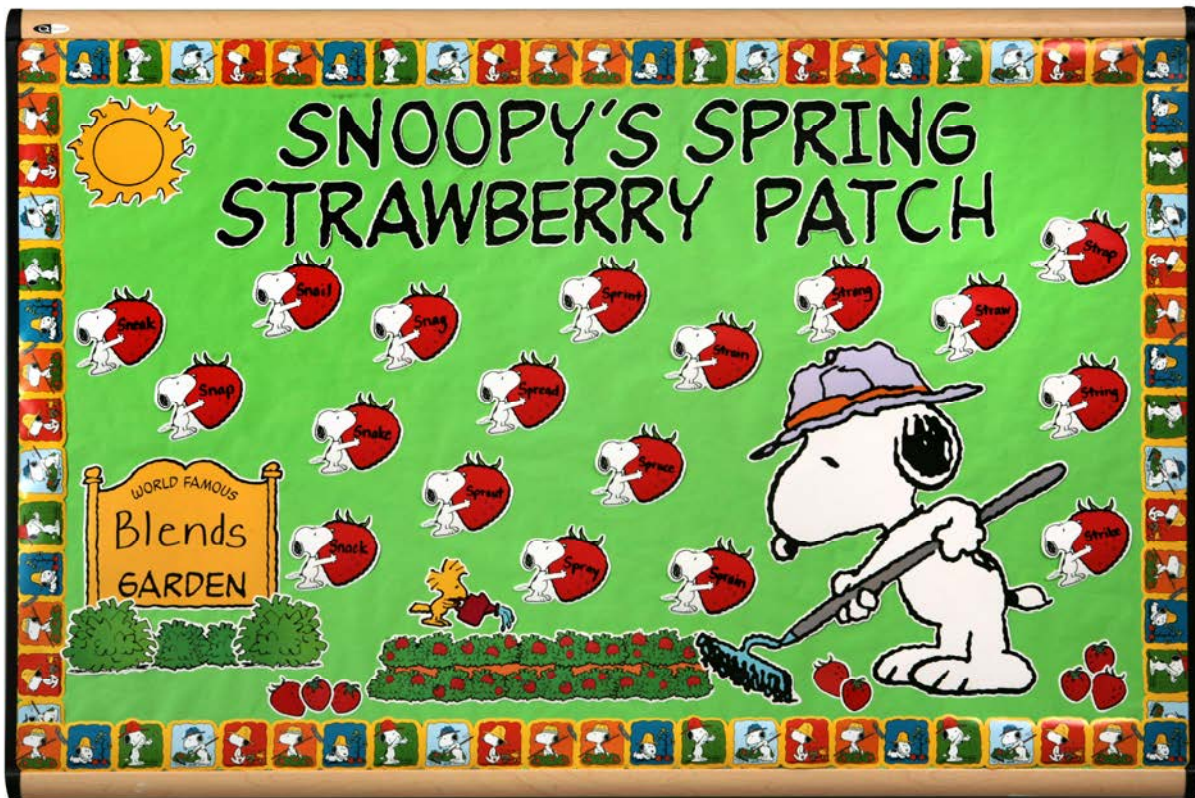


Peanuts® Reading Bulletin Board Project



Supplies Needed:

1. Green Bulletin Board Paper
2. Stapler
3. Black Marker
4. Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Bulleting Board Set (Eureka Item #847686)
5. Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Extra Wide Die Cut Deco Trim® (Eureka Item #845119)
6. Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Paper Cut Outs (Eureka Item #841270)
7. Peanuts® Black Deco Letters

Instructions:

Learning consonant blends is essential for students to increase their reading and writing skills. This project provides a colorful way for teachers to demonstrate examples of words that begin with the initial consonant blends sn, spr, and str.

Step 1: First, cover your bulletin board with green bulletin board paper.

Step 2: Decorate the edges of the bulletin board using Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Extra Wide Die Cut Deco Trim®.

Step 3: Arrange Peanuts® Black Deco Letters to spell out Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch.

Step 4: Decorate your bulletin board using elements from Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Bulletin Board Set, leaving enough room to fill in with Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Paper Cut Outs.

Step 5: Like Snoopy, Spring and Strawberry, select 5-6 words to represent the initial consonant blends sn, spr, and str and write them on Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Paper Cut Outs using black marker. Suggestions include:

sn: sneak, snap, snail, snag, snake, snack

spr: sprint, spread, sprout, spray, spruce, sprain

str: straw, strain, strong, strap, string, strike

Step 6: Arrange your completed Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Paper Cut Outs on the bulletin board.

Get Your Students Involved!

Encourage your students to be involved in the creation of this bulletin board by asking them to suggest words beginning with the appropriate blends, then fill out Snoopy's Spring Strawberry Patch Paper Cut Outs using their correct suggestions.
