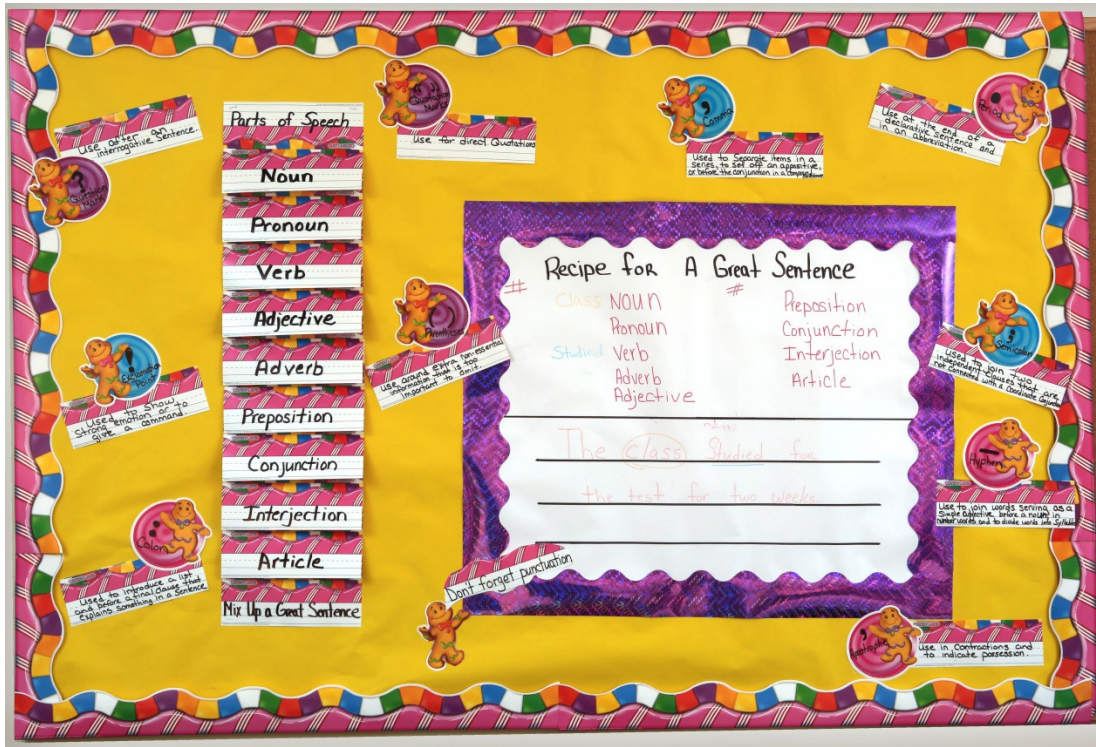


Candy Land™ Parts of Speech Bulletin Board Project



This bulletin board display is a recipe for success when it comes to parts of speech. The class can practice mixing up a great sentence and identifying the parts of speech that make up the sentence they create.

Supplies Needed:

1. Candy Land™ Deco Trim (Eureka # 845152)
2. Deco Trim (Eureka # 845054)
3. Candy Land™ Paper Cut Outs (Eureka # 841294)
4. Candy Land™ Tented Name Plates (Eureka #843508)
5. Stapler or
6. Dry Erase Board or Dry Erase Paper
7. Bulletin board paper

(See instructions below.)

Instructions:

1. Cover bulletin board with paper.
2. Trim the bulletin board with Deco Trim®.
3. Create a sentence recipe card by outlining a dry erase board or dry erase paper with additional Deco Trim® and hang it on the bulletin board.
4. List the parts of speech on the top of the recipe card you created, leaving the rest of the recipe card blank you can add sentences as you use the finished bulletin board project.
5. Using the paper cut outs, list the names of punctuation marks.
6. On the name plates, write definition of each punctuation mark. (Note: these name plates can be cut in half to use on this board.)
7. Create a parts of speech key by stacking and overlapping the remaining tented name plates. On front side, list the part of speech. Then, write examples of this part of speech underneath so they will be reveal when the student lifts the name plate. (See image below as an example.)
